Painting Competition – 2012.Terms and Specifications.

Theme:Immigration

Immigrations affect the geography of earth in various aspects. Political, military, economic, ecological, ethnological...

Immigrations sometimes may be the causes of wars while they also help development of alliances as well as hostilities.

Immigration in essence; is full of freightment, hope, emotional misses and pities.

It is either the emotional misses or the exhaustion of hopes which trigger “return”...

Mankind has illustrated and immortalized evolution of its behaviours through the means of art.

We are looking forward in the foregoing context; to see the pieces of art in painting.

Terms:

- 15 years old and above adults can join the competition.
- The Jury members and their first degree relatives cannot participate in the competition.
- Front sides of the artworks presented must not bear any signature, names and any other kinds of such information. Alias and title of the art piece will be written at the backside.
- The alias which the participants use for their artworks, title of the artwork, name and surname of the participant, resume with photo, address and telephone number will be submitted to Çorlu Culture and Art Association in an enclosed envelope.
- An organization fee will be collected from the participants. This is 2 Euro per artwork and it will not be reimbursed to the payer.
- The fee will be transferred to Yapi Kredi Bank Çorlu/Turkey Branch. Branch code: 105.Account number IBAN: TR49 0006 7010 0000 0086 9449 72. The bank receipt must be submitted in an envelope together with the artwork.
- Artworks must be submitted in suitable condition ready for exhibition.
- The highest prize will be paid in case more than one piece of artwork of the same participants are entitled to win prize.
- In case a jury member can not participate in the evaluation/selection meeting he/she will be replaced by a member of the Association nominated by the Association Board.
- All pieces of art will be returned to the participants after the exhibition. Postal fees will be paid by the participants.
- For any issue which is not mentioned in the specifications, Jury and Association Board’s common decision will be eligible.
- All legal and other responsibilities arising from the artworks will be on the owner of the artworks.

Materials and Techniques

Free (Paper, canvas, gouache, acrylics, oil paint, collage, mixed technique etc.)

Dimensions

Short edge cannot be less than 40 cm and long edge cannot be more than 80 cm. Pieces must be submitted on simple, flat frames.

Submission Period

The pieces must be delivered either by post or cargo until closing business 03 March 2012 or by hand starting from Thursday, 01 March 2012 through Saturday, 03 March 2012 Saturday between 12.00 – 17.00 to the address below:
